Monthly magazine produced by the Urban Land Institute, catering to planning and development professionals.

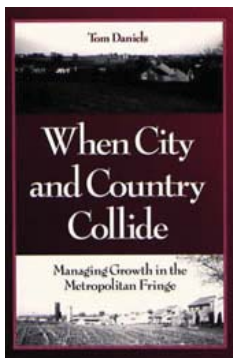

Thomas Sieverts discusses the notion of Zwischenstadt, urban clusters which defy traditional definition as cities.

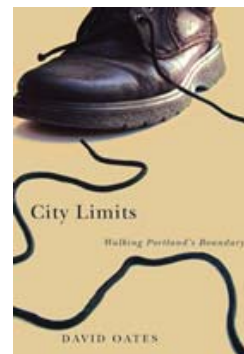

An exploration of the challenges and potential in the increasingly blurred area between urban, rural, and suburban landscapes.

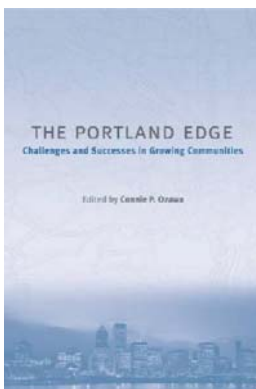
